## PRESTON DONATES ENOUGH FOOD BOXES FOR 9,340 MEALS

Our NPD team at Preston have been busy packing community food boxes at our cold store at King George Dock for those in Hull who are vulnerable during the Coronavirus crisis. This project is part of the council's response strategy, overseen by Hull County Council and in collaboration with Fareshare UK.



## DELIVERING 800 SANDWICHES A DAY TO THE NHS

Our Lazenby's and Sutton Fields sites are doing amazing work to produce and donate 800 sandwiches a day to the NHS Trust with bread supplied from Jacksons Bread.



## CRANSWICK COUNTRY FOODS HULL DONATES TO HULL WOMEN'S AID

Hull Women's Aid is the only refuge-based support in Hull, providing safe accommodation for women and children fleeing domestic abuse. Cranswick Country Foods has donated hampers of meat to distribute to the families, which have been gratefully received.



## DONATING MORE THAN 250 FOOD PRODUCTS WITH FURTHER FUNDING WEEKLY TO LOCAL CHARITIES

Our Milton Keynes colleagues were already working with MK Food Bank before the crisis, and have since upped their community support with weekly emergency food and further funding for three local charities plus their usual Plan Zheroes donations:

- Plan Zheroes: equivalent to 791 meals for the MK Community Fridge at The Old Bath House Community Centre.
- TLG Make Lunch: donations to support hampers for 30 families for three weeks so far, the equivalent of 500 meals. "The hampers have been a lifeline for families, especially those with multiple children."
- MK Food Bank: 20 children's emergency packs a week.
- The Frank Moran Centre and St Marys Church: supporting food parcels for 600 people over 55 and the vulnerable who are isolating.



## CRANSWICK GOURMET PASTRY DONATES 240 ITEMS A WEEK TO LOCAL CHARITIES

Our Gourmet Pastry site has joined forces with multiple organisations to fight hunger, which has never been more critical. Over 500 pies and sausage rolls have been donated to:

- Ryedale Food Bank
- Free Fridges in Norton, Pickering and Malton
- Lazenbys to help produce 800 sandwiches a day for the NHS



## CRANSWICK COUNTRY FOODS WATTON DONATES COMMUNITY FOOD BOXES FOR VULNERABLE LOCAL PEOPLE

Our Watton site has been busy producing and packing joints of pork and packs of sausages. These are for community food boxes for vulnerable people in their local Breckland area.



## CRANSWICK ALLEVIATES FOOD POVERTY WITH EMS

Cranswick already works with EMS by providing meat for their ready meals project from a number of different site locations. EMS makes on average 160 fresh and nutritious meals a week and deliver them out to five community fridges around Hull. During the crisis, Cranswick has joined forces with multiple Hull companies to support the fantastic work EMS does in the community.



## CRANSWICK COUNTRY FOODS HULL DONATES TO HULL SUNDAY SOUP KITCHEN

Our Hull sites have donated multiple contributions of meat which are made into hot and cold meals for Thursday and Sunday night soup kitchens. Pulled pork and rice, pork steak with jacket potato and sliced chicken breast sandwiches are some of the meals that have been shared by this vital lifeline for Hull residents.
